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**Sugar Baby Watermelon:**

Excellent short season variety with reliable yields of sweet, juicy, melons. The standard for small watermelons! Perfectly rounded fruits range from 7-8.5" in diameter with solid green rind and deep red flesh.

**Lunch Box Mini Bell Pepper:**

Beautiful mix of red, yellow, and orange mini-sized peppers. Sweet and flavorful.

**Brad's Atomic Grape Tomato:**

Elongated large cherry tomatoes in clusters. Lavender and purple stripes, turning to technicolor olive-green, red and brown/blue stripes when fully ripe. Really wild! Olive green interior is blushed with red when ripe.

**German Pink Tomato:**

Heirloom variety with high yields of 1-2 lb nearly seedless meaty fruit. Sweet flavor, even floral, and tender skinned. Great for canning, freezing, slicing and juicing.
